ENGLISH



AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Statement 1: The government should subsidize housing projects to make homes affordable for low-income families.

HTC proposes establishing a department that collaborates with FCCA to develop social flat houses. This would allow individuals with lower incomes to purchase homes at a reasonable price, below 85,000 AWG, through mortgages with low-interest rates.

Statement 2: Rent control measures should be implemented to prevent rapid increases in housing costs.

HTC plans to introduce a T-controller department and enact legislation tying conditions to this department, focusing on maintaining rental prices at an appropriate monthly rate. This will also involve restructuring the Rental Commission.

Statement 3: Foreign buyers should pay an additional tax on property purchases to reduce housing scarcity.

HTC believes that all foreign individuals wishing to purchase property in Aruba should pay a higher tax rate. This would provide more opportunities for locals to secure housing.

COST OF LIVING

Statement 4: The minimum wage should be increased to provide a living wage for all workers.

HTC supports a law granting workers an annual wage increase to address the drastic rise in the cost of living. Simultaneously, reforming the payroll tax for businesses will help alleviate the financial burden on employees.

<h2>SUSTAINABLE TOURISM</h2>	
<p>Statement 13: Tourist numbers should be capped to protect Aruba’s natural environment.</p>	<p>HTC believes now is the time to focus on achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) for 2030. Protecting nature structurally while maintaining economic growth is a priority.</p>
<p>Statement 14: All hotels and resorts should be required to meet eco-friendly certification standards.</p>	<p>Certifications are crucial for adhering to international agreements, especially to meet the 2030 goals. HTC envisions Aruba as a leader in sustainable environmental practices.</p>
<p>Statement 15: More funds should be allocated to restore natural areas affected by tourism.</p>	<p>Aruba’s tourism sector generates billions of dollars, and it is vital to prioritize restoring areas affected by tourism to ensure their preservation and proper care.</p>



LABOR CONDITIONS

Statement 16: The government should recruit skilled workers from abroad for sectors facing shortages.

HTC focuses on creating more local professionals to fill positions requiring specific expertise. A pilot project will involve graduates transitioning into open job positions.

Statement 17: The government should mandate flexible work options to improve work-life balance.

HTC supports flexible schedules for all workers. Seniors approaching retirement should have the option to work fewer hours without a salary reduction, focusing on maintaining their health at work.

ALTERNATIVE ENERGY

Statement 18: Government investments in wind and solar infrastructure should be expanded to reduce oil dependence.

HTC aims to achieve the 2030 goals by making alternative energy sources, like solar panels and electric vehicles (EV), more attractive for residents, leading Aruba towards zero emissions.

Statement 19: Homeowners and businesses should receive financial support for installing solar panels.

In collaboration with Elmar, HTC will focus on providing financial support for Aruba's residents to install solar panels, raising awareness and aligning with international progress treaties.



HEALTHCARE & MENTAL HEALTH

Statement 20: The government should increase funding for mental health services to improve accessibility.

HTC supports allocating more funds to mental health departments to ensure patients receive timely help and professional care in severe situations.

Statement 21: Local healthcare providers should be incentivized to stay and practice in Aruba.

HTC aims to make healthcare packages more attractive, ensuring providers feel valued and motivated to continue working on the island.

MIGRATION

Statement 22: Immigration policies should prioritize skilled workers to address labor shortages.

HTC believes everyone residing in Aruba should not be discriminated and have equal opportunities to integrate into the community and contribute with their skills and experience to fill the vacancies.

Statement 23: Temporary work permits should be expedited for foreign workers in sectors with high demand.

HTC advocates for a more innovative and structured permit system with strict management and reduced costs, ensuring foreign workers contribute to current tax structures while maintaining international standards.

EDUCATION & CULTURE

Statement 24: Education in Aruba should place a greater emphasis on preserving and teaching local culture and history.

HTC supports incorporating Aruba's history and culture into school curriculums but also acknowledges that organizing extracurricular activities guided by teachers also positively influences the next generation.

Statement 25: The government should increase funding to support arts and cultural programs across the island.

HTC believes allocating funds is crucial to hosting events that showcase Aruba's artists and culture, strengthening national pride and awareness.



Statement 26: Programs to retain skilled Aruban graduates and reduce brain drain should receive government investment.

HTC intends to introduce scholarships that help young professionals develop their talents, ensuring their success and promoting Aruba internationally.

GOOD GOVERNANCE & FINANCES

Statement 27: Government officials should be subject to stricter transparency and anti-corruption regulations.

HTC supports an independent government department focusing on transparency and integrity. This department would oversee ministries and operate without political influence, as well as enforce strict regulations to combat corruption and mismanagement.

Statement 28: Relations within the Kingdom should be prioritized to foster mutual respect and cooperation.

HTC values mutual cooperation to achieve great goals, as is the case with the *landspakket* agreements, in which the Kingdom receives information and proper guidance from the Netherlands for us to achieve shared goals and maintain alignment within the Kingdom. HTC thinks that acting responsibly makes a difference in unburdening the people.

Statement 29: Reducing Aruba's national debt should take precedence over new government spending.

HTC aims to reduce debt by introducing new economic pillars to boost revenue, enabling the country to address its massive debt while fostering progress, that is why we can make a difference together.

Statement 30: Investment in essential infrastructure should be increased to support economic growth and public welfare.

HTC emphasizes restructuring DOW to address neglected roads and focusing on primary areas requiring attention. Investment in infrastructure is crucial for improvement and development.
